This International Summer School is organized by Jean Monnet Centre of Excellence and the International Organizations and Networks Research Centre together with Tomsk State University. It will take place in Tomsk. Russia on 22-26 June 2016. The participants may choose from a wide range of activities including lectures of outstanding experts, seminars, round work tables and presentations of the participants.

The School is mainly intended for senior students, postgraduate students and young researchers. All the participants will be awarded the certificates.

The topics covered by the Summer School include the following:

- Education and academic mobility in Europe
- Youth adaptation after the graduation
- Youth movement in Europe, youth organizations and networks
- Cross-cultural communication and identity formation of young people
- Social stereotypes among young people

The activities will be held in Russian and English.

Apply for the School by filling in the application form below and sending it to us together with a statement. The latter should make up to 150 words and include the following information: what are your research interests and are they connected with youth problems; why would you like to participate in this School; which issues would you like to discuss within the School activities; what do you expect from the School; how can it be helpful for your research. Each candidate should also outline which topic he or she would like to choose for his/her presentation. The topic will be considered by the Organizing committee and may be then amended only by its consent.

You should also provide a reference signed by your university professor or research supervisor. The application form and a reference should be signed, stamped, scanned and emailed to us. The additional documents such as English proof certificates, CVs and academic achievements' proof may be attached to the email for us to be considered.

The application deadline is 1 June 2016. The application form and the motivation letter should be emailed to: <u>lisbonne@rambler.ru</u>. The organizing committee will choose the participants basing on their academic achievements, research interests and motivation.

International participants may apply for a grant covering the cost of living in Tomsk and a part of their travelling costs. The number of grants is limited.
